



### **Skimmia 'Kew Green'**

This skimmia has pretty green and white flower buds in winter-spring, with a long harvest possible. Shade is desirable.  
Not suitable for clay soils.



### **Skimmia 'Emerald King'**

A richly bloomy variety, with scented flowers. Bronze coloured flower buds appear in autumn-winter. Shade is necessary. It needs to be grown on peaty, sandy or loam soils up to pH6.



### **Skimmia 'Rubinetta'**

Very similar to Rubella, but flowers much more abundantly. The best red pruning skimmia. Red flower buds in autumn-winter. Shade is necessary. It needs to be grown on peaty, sandy or loam soils up to pH6, otherwise the soil needs to be amended.



### **Skimmia 'Ruby King'**

A skimmia with long branches and red flower buds in autumn-winter. The flower buds are smaller than those on other varieties. Shade is necessary. It needs to be grown on peaty, sandy or loam soils up to pH6.
